Brian has appeared at Vienna's Mozartsaal, the Haydnsaal at the Esterhazy Castle in Eisenstadt, Austria, Tokyo's Lilia Hall, and Boston's Jordan Hall.

He is also on the faculties of the Boston Conservatory and the Lied Austria summer program in Graz, Austria. Brian Moll is a graduate of Hamilton College, the Hochschule für Musik in Vienna, and the University of Michigan.

He has accompanied and performed with Boston Lyric Opera, Opera North, and the Vienna Volksoper as well as with the Handel & Haydn and Boston Lyric/Opera New England outreach programs.

The presentation will be supported by excerpts on the piano and by recorded examples with various singers.
