The Franz-Josef-Land, an archipelago in the Arctic was discovered in 1873 by the Austro-Hungarian Northpole Expedition "Tegetthoff" and is a prominent and exciting historical event.



Stephen will talk about the popular frenzy created in the streets and drawing rooms of Vienna by the relatively safe return of Austria's most illustrious and overlooked contribution to polar exploration, the Tegetthoff Expedition, in 1874. This talk examines the reception of this expedition, to see how the experiences of the Habsburg explorers to the Northpole shaped Austrian attitudes toward the world at large, and their own polity's place within it.
